## Requirements & Responsibilities

- Under direction of the IT Director and Senior Database Administrator, enforce both physical and logical security measures to ensure only appropriately authorized individuals can access, add, modify, or delete data in databases
- Under direction of the IT Director and Senior Database Administrator, help create and enforce database standards to ensure and maintain data integrity, system performance, etc
- Install, configure, troubleshoot, and maintain database systems
- Implement, configure, and troubleshoot database instances, replication, backup, partitions, storage, and access
- Monitor and optimize system performance using index tuning, disk optimization, and other methods and prepare documentation of application operating and recovery procedures for the operations staff
- Create, manage, and support SQL Server Integration Services (SSIS) extraction, transformation, and load (ETL) packages between database systems
- Monitor nightly, weekly, or scheduled extract, jobs, and data loading processes to ensure timely and accurate completion
